\*\*\* NOTE: PT Gear consist of gym shorts and t-shirt. No muscle shirts or tank tops. Gold or Yellow shirts with navy blue shorts are preferred.

#### NOTES

- 1) Everyone is required to bring a completed orders and valid USNSCC identification card.
- 2) As always, grooming standards are strictly enforced. Boots shined, uniforms pressed, hair cut, and face shaved. If standards are not met, then cadet will be asked to conform.
- 3) New recruits must have completed the enrollment process to stay overnight. Must have an NSCC ID card.
- 4) All visitors, recruits and cadets must have a refillable water bottle, canteen, or camel back for hydration.
- 5) Buddy drill details: Invite your friends to Jan drill to get free stuff. For cadets to get credit, their friends must respond to headcount and include the name of the cadet that invited them in the comment section. Friends should arrive at drill on Saturday at 1100 and check into the Sea Cadet office. Bring a change of clothes if desired, in case get wet.
- 6) Monitor weather forecast as drill time gets closer. Ensure to pack accordingly for cold and/or rainy weather.
